Who is Bresha Meadows?

Bresha Meadows of Ohio was just 14 years old when she was incarcerated and faced a charge of aggravated murder for defending herself and family against the unrelenting terror and abuse of her father. She is now in juvenile detention.

What's happening on October 6th?

Bresha has an important court hearing this October. During this hearing, the prosecutor will decide on whether to move forward and prosecute Bresha for a crime (possibly **charged as an adult**) instead of providing Bresha with support and safety that she needs as a survivor of violence.
